

Call for Applications/Nominations for *CLAJ* Assistant Editor

Applications and nominations are invited for the position of Assistant Editor of the *College Language Association Journal (CLAJ)*, the official scholarly research publication of the College Language Association.

Duties:

The *CLAJ* Assistant Editor will report to the Editor-in-Chief of the journal. The Assistant editor is expected to offer preliminary reviews of manuscripts submitted by authors, provide constructive comments, and determine manuscripts' suitability for publication and contribution to the field. The Assistant editor is also responsible for general editing, copy editing, cite checking and proofreading. The Assistant Editor will be appointed for a renewable two-year term.

Qualifications:

- CLA membership
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Strong editing, proofreading, research, and writing skills, in addition to a demonstrated interest and background in languages, literature, and pedagogy
- Familiarity with current topics in language, literature, linguistics and pedagogy
- Familiarity with MLA Style Guidelines
- Steady and dependable access to email, library/research facilities and databases for fact and citation checking purposes

Compensation:

In addition to reaping the benefits of producing high-quality scholarly work, engaging with top scholars, and working with a highly motivated Editorial Board, the *CLAJ* Assistant Editor position comes with a stipend and a waiver for CLA Convention registration fees.
